### **Narrative Skills**

*Tell each other stories and encourage pretend play.*

### **Letter Knowledge**

*Help your child learn the first letter in their name and find it in books, on signs and on labels.*

### **Print Awareness**

*Help your child discover how to hold a book, follow the words and turn the pages.*

### **Vocabulary**

*Teach your child names of things, like apple, dog, car and tree.*

### **Print Motivation**

*Find books that fit your child's interests and read them often.*

### **Phonological Awareness**

*Sing songs, play games and share rhymes to help your child play with the sounds in words.*
