

## NAMING OPPORTUNITIES

The Laramie County Library was most grateful for the voter's approval in 2003 of the special 6th penny tax, which, among other things, has paid for the new library in Cheyenne. However, escalation of costs for steel and concrete forced the planners to cut \$7 - \$8 million to stay within budget. That's when members of the LCL Foundation Board set a goal to raise \$3 million to allow planners to return some of the building enhancements back into the plans.

As of August 2009, the board has raised \$1.79 million, leaving a balance of \$1.2 million still needed. Below are listed some of the naming opportunities now available to help the foundation reach its goal. (Although the building is paid for, the Foundation has the obligation to reimburse the library's Operation and Maintenance budget from which loans were made).

The LCL Foundation is an independent, non-profit organization (501) (c) (3). The continuing focus of the Foundation is to solicit donations and grants. All pledges can be received over a period of three years and all amounts are welcome.
