

E-books Overview

General Information

An e-book is an electronically formatted (digital) book, designed to be read from a computer, laptop, smartphone, tablet or an e-reader. An e-reader is an electronic device that is designed primarily for the purpose of reading digital books. Many new e-readers are "web-enabled" which means they have the ability to search the Internet as well as work as an e-reader. This makes downloading titles you check out from the library easier. Older e-readers will require a download to a computer or laptop and then a manual transfer to the e-reader.

Does the library have e-books I can download to my e-reader?

The Wyoming State Library is providing e-book services for all Wyoming residents who have a library card. Your access is through the Laramie County Library System's website <http://LaramieCountyLibrary.org> and by using your library card number and PIN.

Freeding is now available for e-book checkout <http://gowyld.net/econtent/Freeding/index.html>. This service provides e-books from independent publishers. In spring 2012, *3M Cloud Library* will provide access to e-books from most of the major publishers. Watch for more details on both of these services.

Both *Freeding* and *3M Cloud Library* will work with most types of e-readers and tablets including Nooks, Sony Readers, iPads and others. Initially they will work with Kindle Fire, but no other Kindle readers. Other Kindles should work with *Freeding* and *3M Cloud Library* by 2013.

Where else can I get e-books?

There are many places on the web that offer e-books to buy and/or access free. *Project Gutenberg* (projectgutenberg.org) and *MobiPocket* (mobipocket.com) offer free downloads of many e-books. *Google eBookstore* (books.google.com/ebooks) offers free downloads of some e-books and e-books for sale.

Where can I get help with my e-reader?

Review the information in your e-reader's manual, or go to the appropriate website for your device. Java Script will need to be enabled on any web-enabled reader to use the library's wireless service.
